Beach School Project- comes to an end this week. All children have participated in this special work & have enjoyed their learning & adventures at the beach.



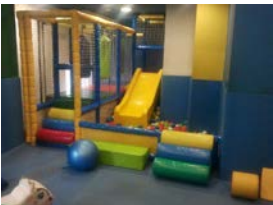
Garden Week- thanks to all who helped during garden week, your generous donations of plants & help have really made the outdoors look wonderful.
