June 13<sup>th</sup> - Vicky Holbrough will be working with the children on the P's in the Pod project.

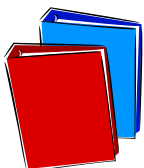
June 16<sup>th</sup> - Nursery closed - Staff training day.
