If you can come along please see Mrs Scott or Mrs Wilson.

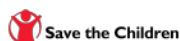
If you can contribute any plants/bulbs these will be greatly received.



June 14th - Nursery closed - Staff training day.

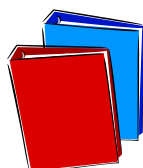
June 21st - Fancy Dress Sponsored Walk for "Save the Children".
