We will be raising money for Marie Curie Cancer Research. Children can wear something yellow & buy their daffodil bulb in the pot they planted last November (£1 donation).

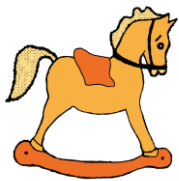
