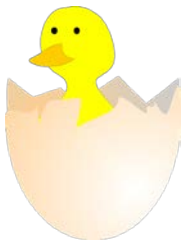
Welcome back after the Easter holidays please can you take a few minutes to complete & return a 'Story from Home' sheet for your child's learning journey.
