June 15th, June 29th, July 6th & July 13th 6pm - Parent Meetings for children starting nursery. (Please note these are for adults only).

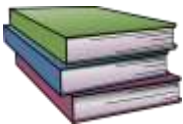
June 17th - Nursery closed - Staff training day.
