If we have no children booked in, then we will close.

We have a skeleton staff working and your child may not know some of them very well. We will do our best to support the children through this. If your child is upset, you must still observe the request to wait outside and distance yourself from the staff. These are different circumstances and the school staff will not be put at any unnecessary risk.

If your child does not settle, we will telephone you as normal to discuss this. The children are our main priority and we cannot have them developing a negative view of going to school. If your child or any family members develop any symptoms of COVID 19 they must not attend but isolate following Public Health England advice.

We will try to distance the children from one another wherever we can e.g. at snack time and at lunch time for example children will not sit next to one another as they normally would.

THIS SERVICE WILL BE REVIEWED ON A WEEKLY BASIS TO ASSESS RISK FOR THE STAFF IN CONTINUING TO CARRY OUT THIS ROLE.

If any staff go into isolation with symptoms, we will have to review the offer to ensure the safety and welfare of the children.
