

Bird Feeder





What you will need:

- Cheerios (or another hoop shaped cereal)
- Pipe cleaners, string or wool (anything you can thread the cheerios onto)

What to do:

- Pour some cereal into a bowl.
- Make a knot at the end of the pipe cleaner (or thread you are using).
- One by one thread the cereal onto the pipe cleaner.
- Tie the end once its full.
- Make a few! If you are using pipe cleaners you can bend them into different shapes. Who can make the longest feeder? Tie some together!
- Place your feeders onto a tree, plant, fence, washing line and watch the birds come to eat it!
- Count how many birds you find! Talk about what they look like, their sizes, shapes, colours.
