

Puffy Paint!

Puffy paint is paint that puffs up when microwaved!

To make you need:

- Self-raising flour (about 1 cup)
- Bicarbonate of soda (approx. 1-2 teaspoons)
- Food colouring (as much or as little as you want depending on how strong you want the colour to be)
- Water (to thin the mixture)

Place all of the ingredients into a container (to make a thick batter consistency – thicker than Yorkshire pudding mix) and mix together.

Blob the mixture onto paper using as many or as few colours as you want.

Place the picture into a microwave and cook for 20 seconds (if the paint is applied thinly try 10 seconds) If the paint is still wet microwave for a further 10 seconds or until the paint has dried).

The paper and puffy paint will be hot when you take it out so please be careful!!!
