

Rhyming Soup



'Rhyming Soup' or 'Silly Soup' is a fun way of developing an awareness of rhythm and rhyme in speech.

- Collect a spoon and bowl and selection of objects that rhyme (at least 2 of each, 3 if possible) such as box, socks and fox, hat, bat and cat, hen and pen, coat, goat and boat etc.
- Adult to place an object in the bowl and ask your child to add another object(s) that rhymes (hat and cat)
- Stir rhyming objects together and sing this rhyme to the tune of Pop Goes The Weasel;

We're making lots of silly soup

We're making soup that's silly

We're going to cook it in the fridge

To make it nice and chilly

- When finished take out the objects pretend to eat the soup and start again with more objects
