

You will need: Dice Pom poms (if you do not have pom poms to hand, you can use things such as buttons, even coloured pieces of paper, anything suitable to pick up and count) What you need to do: Get your child to roll the dice. Count the dots on the top face of the dice together. Then, get your child to pick up the correct number of pom poms to match the dice. If your child seems to be comfortable doing this, then you can ask them to remove each pom pom and count down, all the way to Zero!
