



Magnetic fish

What you need:

- Pieces of cardboard
- Decorative materials
- Marker or decorative numbers
- Pipe cleaner/ string
- Metal rod or wooden dowel
- Paper clips/washer
- Small magnet
- Bowl, bucket, tray or floor

Number of players 2+

What to do

Using the large cardboard cut into 5 (or however many you want) fish shapes. Then decorate each fish using the decorative materials, you could colour them in, paint them or glue small pieces of material and add glitter to them. Once the fish are complete and dry add a number onto one side of the fish or onto the fish's tail using a marker or decorative numbers. Then place one paper clip or you could glue or sew a washer onto each of the fish. Then to make a rod you can use a piece of wood dowel, wooden spoon or a metal rod and attach a piece of string or pipe cleaner to it then place and attach a small magnet to the other end of the string or pipe cleaner. Or if you have a magnetic rod from another game you could use this. Then you can either place the fish on the floor or into a bowl or bucket whatever you decide and take turns catching fish and seeing which number you have caught.
