

Initial Sounds



Objectives:

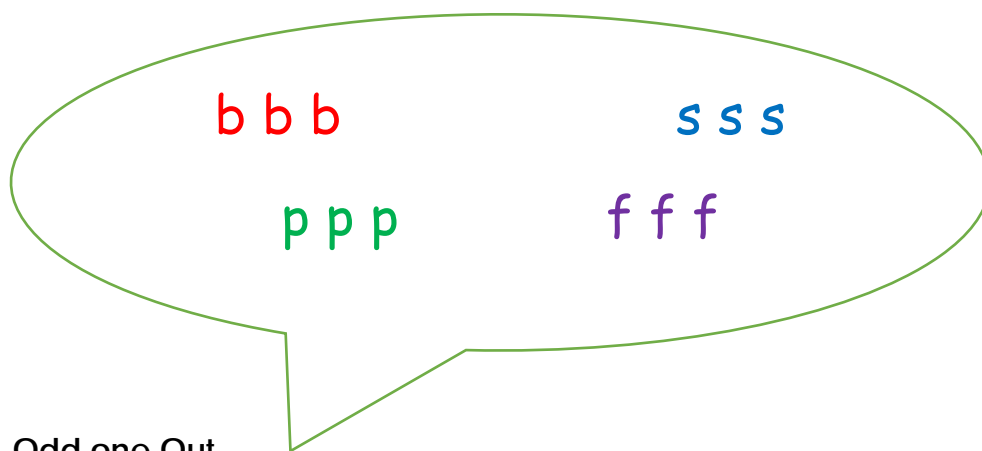
Able to identify initial sounds

Able to say the sound correctly

Activity 1 Say the Sound

- Make collections of objects with names beginning with the same sound e.g. book, bag, belt, ball. Place each set in a bag or box (one set at a time).
- Create a song, such as 'What have we got in our sound box today?' and then ask your child to take 1 object out at a time and say what it is.
- Emphasise the initial sound (e.g. b-b-b-bag, b-b-b-book, b-b-b-ball)

Once your child has become familiar with identifying initial sounds you could try activity 2



Activity 2 Odd one Out.

- Using your sets of objects place one set of objects with the same initial sound plus one object with another initial sound on a tray or some paper. For example, sock, snake, sausage, apple.
- Ask your child to find the odd one out and say what it is – a-a-a apple.
