

Rhyming words game!



Why not play a rhyming words pairs game today?

What to do - If you can print. (Resources are on the next page)

- Print out the rhyming word cards and cut them up.
- Make sure your child knows what each picture is, talk about them and name them.
- Turn them face down and take it in turns to choose two. Do they rhyme? If they do have another turn, if not turn them back over!
- The winner is the person to find the most rhyming pair cards! Can you count how many cards you have? How many pairs is that?

What to do - If you can't print.

- Can you find items about your home that rhyme?
- Give your child an item, can they find a word to rhyme with it?
- If your child is struggling walk with them, for example, you have given them a hat. Name objects as you walk - hat and cup? No not rhyming words. Hat and toilet? No not rhyming words. Hat and mat? YES, rhyming words!
- How many pairs of rhyming objects did you find? Can you count them.



Think of more rhyming words, use the internet to find pictures and print them out.
