



Counting with objects

What you need: paper, red pencil/crayon, set of up to 10 objects.

With your child you could create your own strawberry using paper and red coloured pens. Ask your child to pick a number between 1 and 5, then put that number of objects onto your strawberry.

Extend by using larger numbers



Sound Hunt

Look around inside or outdoors for objects beginning with **s** as in strawberry or **m** as in mouse or **b** as in bear etc.

How many did you find and can you name the object?

Examples

b for bed, bird or ball s for sandwich, stick or sock m for money, mud or milk.

<u>Qutting</u> Fruit

Have a selection of fruit.

With your child cut the fruit into small pieces.

Make a repeating pattern for example, strawberry, banana, apple, strawberry, banana, apple etc.

You could make a fruit kebab or, simply place the fruit on your plate and eat it Yum, yum!
