### Matching Socks

Pick a variety of different sizes, styles, colours and designs of socks and encourage the children to match the socks together. Count how many socks and how many pairs. Which are the big socks? Which are the little socks? Talk about the colours and patterns.



Can you measure in socks?  
How long in socks are you? Measure how long you are using socks. How many socks did you use? Can you measure other things at home, for example family members or your favourite toys using socks? Which one has the longest sock trail and which one has the smallest trail?

### Create a story bag

Collect a toy teddy or favourite cuddly toy, it doesn't have to be a fox, and go on a hunt to try and find the items in your house from the story that are needed to dress fox. Re-enact the story using the things you have collected.



Rhyming words  
Is this story a rhyming story?  
Explore the words and see if your child can identify the rhyming words. Can you think of other things that rhyme with the words. For example, what other things rhyme with hat... cat, sat, bat etc.
