

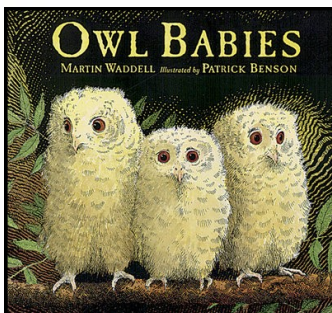
Whatever Next Activities
