Gruffalo Paw Biscuits

You will need:

250g of butter

350g light soft brown sugar

2 large eggs

350g self-raising flour

100g cocoa powder

White chocolate buttons (for middle of the cookie)

White chocolate drops (for the claws)

Gruffalo Playdough:

You will need:

1 cup of flour

1/2 cup of salt

1 cup of water

1 table spoon of oil

Brown paint or food colouring

What to do:

Mix all of the ingredients in a microwavable bowl, put into the microwave for 2 minutes, stir and repeat until the mixture has came together into a ball and isn't sticky. Then enjoy!!

Use straws, buttons, raisins or whatever you have to hand to add features to your Gruffalo.



Gruffalo walk
