## The Smartest Giant in Town



Can you get a collection of socks of all different varieties, big, small and different patterns and colours from around the home and get the children to match them into pairs? You could also sort them into big and small or colours and patterns.

Look together at the Giants tie. Ask your child to describe the tie (the colours and pattern). Have a go at drawing his tie with 2 or 3 different colours? Can they make any other patterns? They could stick the tie that they have made to the giant they are making ready for the re-tell of the story!

## Make your own Giant-
