



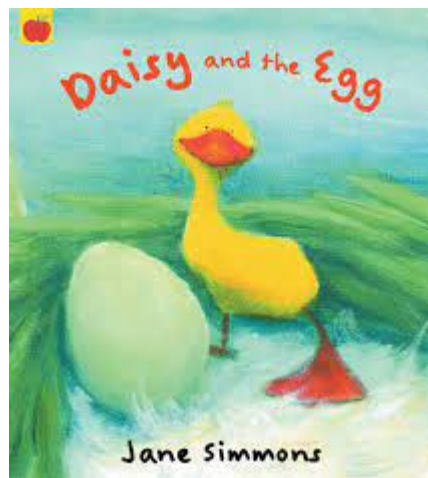
Making your own egg

You will need; glue a range of different collage materials, sequins and paper or card. With your child you could make your own Easter eggs out of paper or card. You could cut out different sized eggs and decorate them. If you don't have any creative materials, felt tipped pens are just as good!



Making water play fun

For this activity ducks are a great idea but if you haven't got ducks you could use any bath toys and put them in the water. If you have an empty spray bottle you could fill it with water and squirt the toys to move them. To extend this you could make up a racing game with your child using the bottles to see which duck/toy can get to the finish line first.



Making nests

With your child you could look around your garden for sticks and create your own nests to put some eggs inside. Once they have done this they could choose their favourite soft toy to put on the top of the eggs.
